



## Tournament Rules and Regulations

As an officially sanctioned BC Youth Soccer Association event, the Slurpee Cup 2008 will be played under FIFA Rules – with the following additions and/or exceptions:

1. Each team will play 3 Round Robin games and a Championship or Consolation game. **Games must start on time.** Please be at the field at least 30 minutes prior to game time.
2. All games will consist of two 30-minute halves. No overtime will be played during Round Robin games. Championships games that are tied after regulation time will go directly to penalty kicks to determine a winner.
3. Teams will be awarded points according to the following: (a) Win = 3 points, Tie = 1 point, Loss = 0 points. In the case of a forfeit, the winning team is awarded a 2-0 victory.
4. Unlimited substitutions allowed during game play, with the permission of the referee.
5. All players must be properly registered and insured by their host soccer associations. All players from B.C. based teams must be registered with BCSA.
6. Two yellow cards in any game or concurrent games will result in the player's disqualification from the next tournament game. A red card will result in that player receiving a disqualification from the next tournament game.
7. All players, coaches, bench personnel and spectators are expected to conduct themselves in a manner consistent with the spirit as well as the letter of the Law of the Game. Referees have been specifically instructed to run the games according to this spirit and will act accordingly. Dissent from players, coaches, bench personnel and/or spectators will not be tolerated; cautions and/or dismissals will result. The Tournament Director reserves the right to terminate the participation of a team in the tournament if the behavior of the player(s), coach(es), bench personnel and/or spectators creates an atmosphere in which a match(es) cannot be completed with the spirit and letters of the Laws.
8. Any disputes or protests must be forwarded to the Tournament Director within 60 minutes after the game has ended. The Tournament Director's decision is final in any dispute.
9. All players will receive a tournament t-shirt and food vouchers.
10. Most Valuable Player awards will be awarded to one player from each team after each game.
11. The first and second place teams in each division will play in the Championship game. The third and fourth place teams will play in the consolation games. **Scores and standings will be posted at Heritage Wood High School field near the concession.** In the event of tie between two or more teams after the Round Robin games, the following tie breaker rules will be used: 1. Record against each other from Round Robin play. 2. Overall goal difference. 3. Lowest goals against. 4. Highest goals scored. 5. If still tied, a final determination will be made by the Tournament Director.
